History of Windance



Development History

Development of Windance began in 1986 offering residential properties, many of them being waterfront, nestled around an 18-hole championship golf course and a 100 acre lake. Windance over the years has expanded to seven phases and today has over 300 family dwellings. Residents enjoy a beautiful lake and a wide-open golfing community that has many breath taking views with plentiful wildlife.

Windance has maintained its appeal and standards over the years. A friendly community, beautiful lake, championship golf course, active Windance Property Owners Association (WPOA) membership, and a covenant controlled community are the major contributors.

Golf Course History

The golf course was designed by Mark McCumber in 1986. This 18-hole championship course features over 6,600 yards of challenging golf complete with breathtaking landscapes, rolling hills and lush greens.

Windance club house and golf course were purchased by Island View Casino Resort in 2007, Windance has recently been transformed into one of Mississippi's top resort golf courses. Significant renovations include: the addition of new, state-of-the-art irrigation systems, a new lake, new native areas and decorative stone work.

Named Golfweek magazine's "Best Places You Can Play" for three consecutive years, Windance has a 4 star rating by Golf Digest magazine and has been host to both the Ben Hogan and Nike tours with past winners including: 2003 U.S. Open Champion Jim Furyk, 1996 The Open Champion Tom Lehman, and 2005, 2006 Senior Open Champion Alan Doyle.

Welcome to Windance and the Windance Property Owners Association (WPOA). We hope this information will be helpful to you.

All property owners have a required and automatic membership in the Windance Property Owners Association (WPOA) which means members have voting rights at the Annual Members Meeting, may hold a position on the Board of Directors, and may use any of the designated "Common Areas". It is the responsibility of owners and residents of Windance to abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in the ByLaws, Covenants and Restrictions, and other directives as approved by the Board of Directors. The Windance WPOA e-mail address <code>windancepoa@yahoo.com</code> is a source for area updates and alerts, so we invite members to join the account by providing us with your e-mail address. Please feel free to contact your Board of Directors (listed below) with any concerns.

WPOA members pay annual dues. The timely payment of dues are vital to sustaining Windance's appearance as these funds are used to offset the costs of the operation and maintenance of entrance signs, landscaping, irrigation at both entrances, upkeep of all common areas, community social events, special projects, and WPOA administration. Members are billed annually and payment is due in January. New member dues will be prorated and billed based date of property purchase.

The Windance POA is self-managed by a nine person Board of Directors. Directors are elected to three year terms at the annual Members Meeting held in January. An official mailing is sent to all members well in advance of the meeting specifying the exact time, date, and place, along with the meeting agenda, proxies, list of candidates for election to the Board and other pertinent information. The specific Board offices and positions are elected from within the Board at an organizational meeting. The Board meets the second Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. at the Windance Golf Course restaurant. All owners are invited to attend and share suggestions, concerns, and questions.

Fun on Adams Lake!



Quick Reference of Covenants

The following is a Quick Reference of several of our Restrictive Covenants:

The Windance Architectural Review Committee must be contacted for approval before most exterior home improvements or construction projects are started. Examples of projects requiring approval include painting, re-roofing, pool or pool enclosure installation, fence or storage shed installation, or taking down any tree larger than 6" in diameter. A written request must include all pertinent data including any architectural drawings and specifications, types of material, colors, and a copy of the County Building Permit (as required). The requesting party should allow sufficient time (at least one month) before the start of construction for the committee to meet, review the plans, visit the site, and respond with a decision in writing. Since utility lines are underground in Windance, the cable, phone, and power companies should be contacted before digging begins on a property.

"No lot shall be used for any purpose except residential."--- Therefore, no commercial or business operations are permitted from any residence.

Our community is pet friendly. As a courtesy to your neighbors and in accordance with county ordinances, pets must be on a leash and pet waste must be removed and properly disposed of in a trash container.

NO vehicles are to be parked on lawns or overnight on the street. Boats, boat trailers, cargo and utility trailers, campers, motor homes and RVs are to be kept in the garage not in the driveway.

Homeowners are responsible for mowing and edging their lawns on a regular basis in order to maintain the appearance and standards of our community. Beautification Awards are given monthly for outstanding accomplishments. If you are renting your home, please contact the owner to determine who will be doing the lawn maintenance.

HOW DO I GET INVOLVED AS A MEMBER IN THE WPOA AND WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE IN "GOOD STANDING"? All property owners have a required and automatic membership in the Windance Property Owners Association (WPOA). To be in "good standing" means that WPOA dues are current and there are no liens against the property owned.

ARE ALL UNITS' COVENANTS THE SAME? No. As each unit was built, the developer implemented the covenants for that section. The covenants are posted on our website **www.windancepoa.com**.

DOES THE WPOA HAVE A SET OF BYLAWS THAT GOVERNS THE ASSOCIATION? Yes. BYLAWS were adopted in 1994 and are used as a guideline by the Board of Directors to conduct business.
